Virtual German-Yemeni Winter School, 12-16 December 2021

Call for Applications

This five-day virtual Winter School is part of a wider project the *Institute of Oriental and Asian Studies (IOA)* at the University of Bonn, Germany, is currently implementing with the *Gender-Development Research & Studies Center (GDRSC)* at the University of Sana'a, Yemen, and *CARPO – Center for Applied Research in Partnership with the Orient* in Bonn, Germany. The objective of this project is to support (the planning of) post-conflict reconstruction by strengthening ties between researchers, academic staff, students, and experts in the policy and development community working on and in Yemen.

The Winter School will bring together advanced academics and teachers from all three institutions with MA students from Yemen and Germany with an interest in post-conflict reconstruction. The aim is to jointly further our knowledge of post-conflict reconstruction theories, fields of practice as well as approaches and challenges to post-conflict reconstruction while exchanging knowledge, experiences and ideas across (academic) cultural divides. Practitioners involved in (planning for) the post-conflict reconstruction process in Yemen will be invited to talk about their work to the students.

Who can apply? German master students studying in Germany

Application deadline: 10 October 2021

Selection criteria: We are looking for students with good knowledge of English, who either have a demonstrated interest in academic approaches to post-conflict reconstruction, social transformation, development, gender, and conflict studies etc. *or* who are or have been actively engaged in social and/or professional activities in above fields.

What to submit for application:

- A CV (in English) with a particular focus on the above criteria;
- A cover letter (in English), elaborating on your interest in the Winter School.
